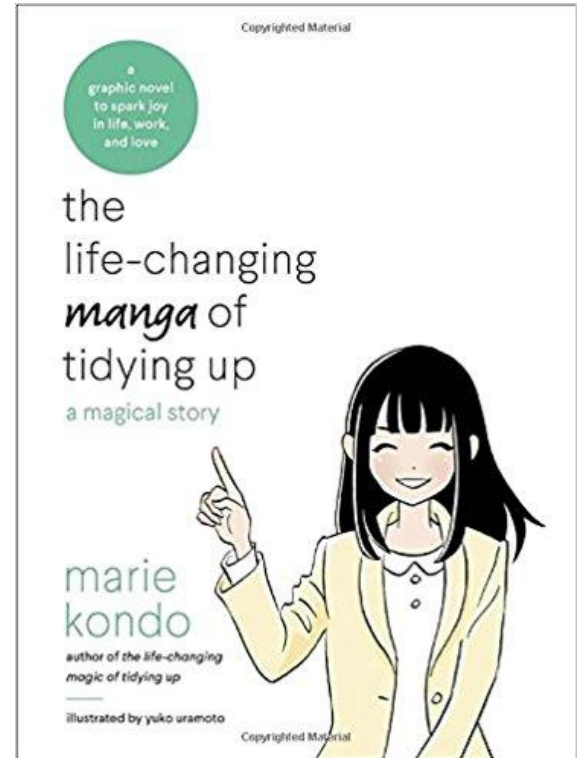


Title: the life-changing manga of tidying up

Marie Kondo

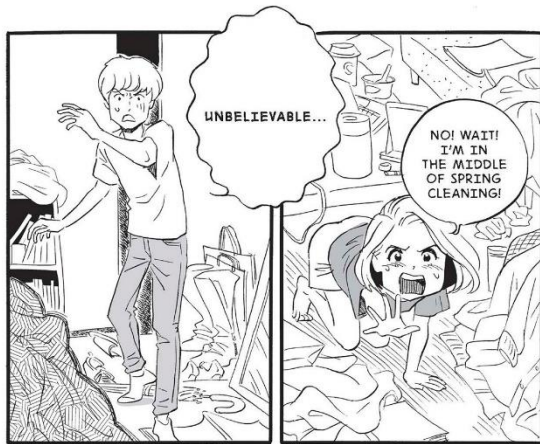
Tidying consultant. Nickname: KonMari. Has a winning smile but is an exacting instructor.

Good-looking guy who lives in the apartment next to Chiaki's. Works as a cook at a cafe. Likes to keep things tidy.

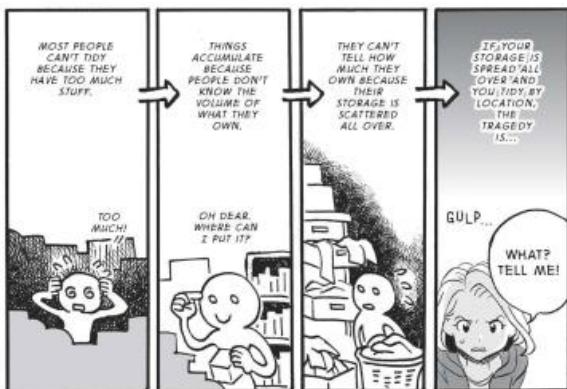

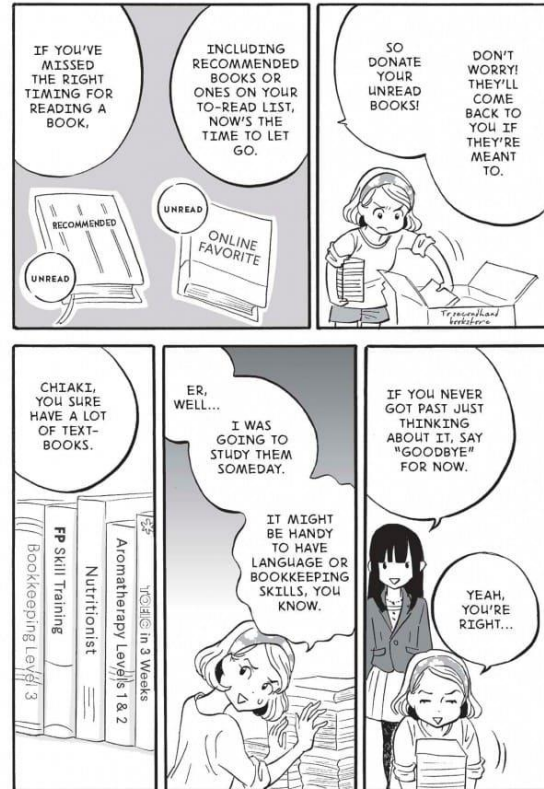
