

#### Comics

- · slim, softcover
- · stapled like a magazine
- often published monthly as part of a series

Recognized subsets with distinct cultural artistic influence and content:

- manga (Japan)
- manhwa (South Korea)
- manhua (China, Taiwan, Hong Kong)

#### Sequential Art

- tells story and/or information (any genre)
- words and images laid out in a particular order (sometimes wordless)

#### Graphic Novels

- bound as hard or softcover book, and/or eBook
- may be a stand-alone story
- often a compilation of previously published comic chapters

A "Cartoon" is typically a single drawing rather than a series of sequential panels.

#### Webcomics


#### Reluctant Readers

"Comic books do have a more radical, dissident dimension to them," Carleton said, noting that many comics have been part of "underground, countercultural movements."



"(Readers) have to piece together incomplete texts and images, and that allows the reader to become an active agent in the storytelling process...There is a lot of opportunity for people to connect to the story in a more active and engaged way."

This is exactly what Elkadri hopes her illustrations will accomplish — helping people of colour heal, in addition to sparking cross-cultural dialogue.

Shraya is also the author of the essay *I'm Afraid of Men* and poetry collection *even this page is white*.

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


### About the cartoonist

#### 1. CREATE AUTOBIOGRAPHICAL COMIX

At the beginning of each new school year have students create on autobiographical comic strip talking about themselves and their families or summarizing the most important things about their lives, including their goals both in school and in life.

Let each student select a cartoon character as a surrogate to represent her or him. After students complete their strips, encourage them to exchange their comics with classmates to learn more about each other. Students can also create strips that summarize what their individual interests are to help a teacher to learn more about them. These autobiographical comic strips can become the opening pages of a daily comix diary that students can be encouraged to keep throughout the school year. #### 2. PRACTICE NEW VOCABULARY WORDS

Have students create a comic strip story using new vocabulary words that are being taught. Having students fill in talk or thought balloons for different cartoon characters also helps students practice conversation and language structure in a meaningful context. And what a fun way for students to improve their writing, reading and storytelling skills!

#### 3. PROMOTE TEAM COLLABORATION


Have students break up into pairs or group teams to create their comic strips together. This approach encourages teamwork and cooperation, with students complementing the skills of their colleagues. The site also provides a structure for students to work individually as they create their own cartoon worlds using their imaginations. Look upon the site as a resource for literacy development and to reach out to engage reluctant writers and readers.

#### 4. PRACTICE CONVERSATION SKILLS FOR ESOL STUDENTS

Having students in English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) classes fill in talk or thought balloons for different cartoon characters helps them practice
