
Pronunciator is an online language learning system available to you through your library providing access to 80 foreign language courses and 51 English courses (taught in the user's native language).

- 3. Enter your library card number and PIN (if you do not know your library PIN, please contact your local library)
- 4. First-time users will create a Pronunciator username and password by clicking on the REGISTER button
