

What is a Theremin?

In 1919, a young Russian scientist was working on using radio waves to create a device that could measure the density of different gasses in the air. This scientist was **Leon Theremin**, and he realized that his own movements were interfering with the radio waves, and created an audible tone that changed as he moved. He realized that he could actually play the sounds coming from his device, and after some adjustments, the **Theremin** as we know it was created.
